Scholarships Available

Oregon Concrete & Aggregate Producers Association (OCAPA) educational fund is sponsoring scholarships for deserving students pursuing a career related to the construction materials industry. Areas of study may include, but are not limited to, construction materials, engineering, geology, architecture, land use planning, biology, Environmental Law and fish & wildlife studies.

WHO MAY APPLY?

Any junior, senior, or graduate students enrolled at an Oregon university or college encompassing disciplines related to the construction materials industry may apply who will be enrolling full time in an academic institution for the year beginning in September following the date of application. Students must be citizens of the United States.

The academic institution may be either a university or a community college with a recognized related course of study. Scholarships will be applied toward full or part-time tuition costs for one calendar year,.

WHAT MUST ACCOMPANY THE APPLICATION?

To guarantee the application will be reviewed by the OCAPA Educational Fund committee, the following materials must be included with the application:

1. A transcript of college grades through the latest grading period prior to the date of application. (Official or unofficial)
2. A letter of recommendation from a professor, employer or other relevant acquaintance.
3. A 300 to 500-word statement of his/her career plan and how it relates to the construction materials industry.

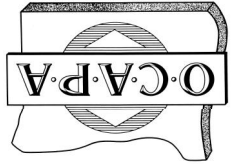
