Friends,

On December 31 of this year your 2015 Oregon Political Tax Credit will expire – now is the time to use your credit, or you'll lose it for another year!

As most of you know, one of our Association's priorities is to help elect candidates to state and local offices in Oregon who support the construction materials industry. We fund these efforts through your contributions to our Political Action Committee, OCAPA PAC.

Oregon has a unique tax law known as the "Oregon Political Tax Credit." The Political Tax Credit allows a person to contribute up to \$50 (\$100 for a married couple) to an Oregon PAC and take an Oregon tax credit (not a deduction) for every dollar they have contributed.

As you know, a credit is a dollar-for-dollar tax reduction. In other words, if you contribute \$50 to a registered Oregon PAC like OCAPA PAC, you will pay \$50 less in Oregon state income tax. **The end result is that your PAC contribution costs you nothing!**

There is no reason why every taxpaying Oregonian, regardless of political belief, should not use their political tax credit. The purpose of the tax credit is to encourage Oregonians to support candidates/political causes they believe in. What better way to do so than to allow citizens to give up to \$50 per person and take that money off of their state tax bill!

If you support the aggregate, ready mix concrete, and construction materials industry, what better way for you to show your support than by contributing to OCAPA PAC and reducing your Oregon income taxes by the amount of your PAC contribution? After all, would you rather give \$50 to support a PAC that is organized exclusively to elect pro-industry legislators and local officials, or would you rather give that \$50 to the State of Oregon to pass on to state agencies who are working to regulate and tax the construction materials industry? The choice seems pretty clear, doesn't it?

The 2015 Oregon Political Tax Credit ends on December 31, 2015. A contribution made prior to that date to OCAPA PAC qualifies for the tax credit, which you can find on your Oregon income tax form.

Can we count on your support? Please make a contribution to OCAPA PAC, and take advantage of your 2015 Oregon Political Tax Credit. If you don't use it by December 31, it will be gone.
